Hold Fast

Many of us will never forget where we were on September 11, 2001. We watched in horror as four passenger planes became instruments of death and destruction. The pictures and videos captured the events, but they could not capture the devastation inflicted on our sense of peace, safety, and hope.

For quite some time, we wondered not if, but when, it would happen again. Nowhere seemed completely safe. Churches were filled with people reaching for something that could offer hope, assurance, and peace in the midst of fear.

Twenty-five years later, our sense of security, though never fully restored, has found a new normal. Yet the need for the hope our faith offers remains.

We gather today as a faith community because we know the power of faith—not a power that lords over others, but one that brings peace in the midst of chaos, hope in the midst of uncertainty, and community when we feel alone. Our faith does not promise that tragedy, grief, and loss will somehow pass us by. It reminds us that they will not have the final word.

As we remember those who lost their lives on 9/11 and those whose lives were forever changed, we hold fast to our faith and to God’s promise that “death will be no more; mourning and crying and pain will be no more, for the first things have passed away” (Revelation 21:4).

In the end, God wins.

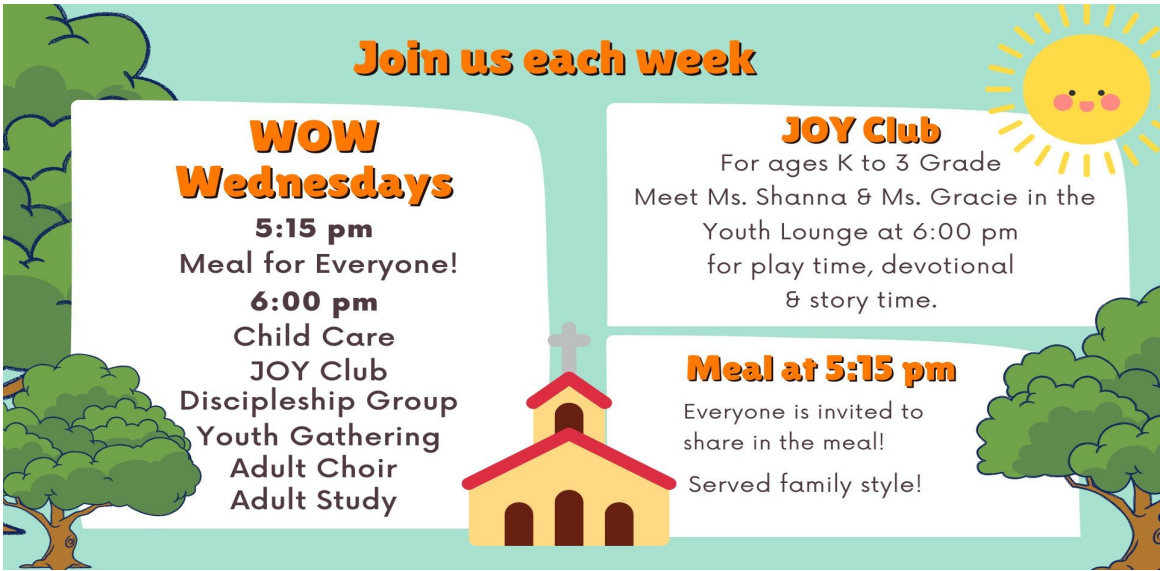
