Happenings at CCC—

Tomorrow Starts Today

A friend once shared his go-to prayer before an exam he hadn’t prepared for: “God, help me make the best of the situation I’ve gotten myself into.” I suspect we’ve all prayed some version of that prayer.

Most of the situations we get ourselves into don’t just happen. They are shaped by choices we make along the way. That may be why we need prophets.

The prophet asks us to look honestly at ourselves. Are we living what we say we believe? Do we treat one another in ways that are pleasing to God? Are our priorities consistent with God’s priorities? Are we becoming the people God is calling us to be?

The prophets were less concerned with telling people what was going to happen tomorrow than with reminding them what God desires from us today. They spoke when the poor were neglected, when justice was ignored, when power was abused, and when people became comfortable with things that break God’s heart. They warned where those choices would lead.

Sometimes the best way to avoid asking God to help us out of the situation we’ve gotten ourselves into is to listen before we get there.

Micah’s message was simple: “What does the Lord require of you?” Do justice. Love kindness. Walk humbly with God. (Micah 6:8)

That is why we need the prophetic voice in the church today. Not because prophets have a crystal ball, but because we occasionally lose our way and need to be reminded who we are, who we belong to, and what really matters to God.

The question is whether we are willing to listen—especially when the prophetic voice tells us something we would rather not hear. Are we willing to change our priorities, our behavior, or even our minds when they no longer reflect the heart of God?

Maybe prophets actually do tell us something about the future after all.

They remind us that our tomorrow starts with what we do today.

So, what will you do with today?
