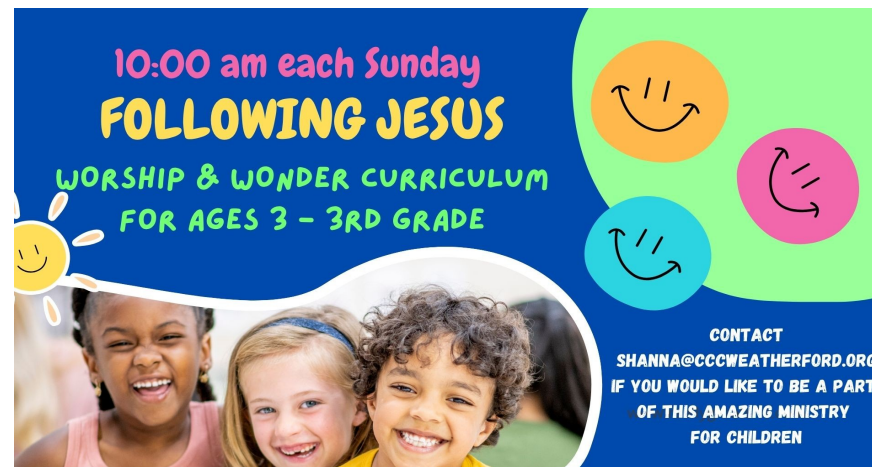

The Bible: How to Live a Carefree Life

I think we can all agree that the Bible is foundational to our faith development. Problem is, sometimes we treat it like a self-help, how-to book. As if we can just find the right verse, follow the directions, and all our problems are solved. Easy-peasy. Sometimes it works, but too often it doesn't.

But when we truly study Scripture, we meet Abraham slowly learning to trust, Moses reluctantly answering God's call, and David getting it right—and getting it horribly wrong. We watch the disciples bumble along trying to understand Jesus. Turns out, nobody in the Bible seems to be living a particularly carefree life.

Over time, those stories become part of us. We begin to see ourselves in Abraham, Moses, David, and even the disciples. Most importantly, we watch Jesus show us what love looks like in real life. The good news is that eventually, the stories become so much a part of us that they shape how we respond when life happens. Before we know it, we begin to instinctively choose grace, forgiveness, generosity, justice, and love—even when there isn't a handy Bible verse telling us exactly what to do.

The Bible transforms us.

There's a reason the subtitle of the Bible isn't How to Live a Carefree Life. The Bible doesn't make life carefree. It changes the people living it.

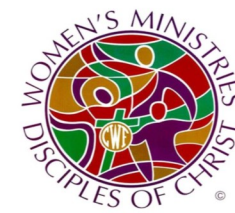
HELPERS WANTED: If you have not yet signed up for being a HELPER, please talk to an elder or get in touch with Sandy Hughes—817-805-0319.

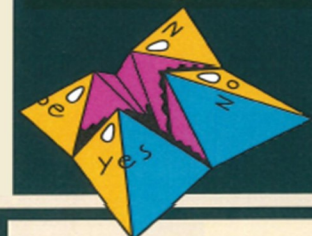
